Returning to School after Spring Break: If you are planning to travel outside the state of Florida, particularly if you are planning to fly, your child will either need to have a negative test result upon return, or must quarantine for 7 days before returning to school. If there are no Covid symptoms, the student may return to school after quarantining for 7 days. If there are Covid symptoms, the student must quarantine for 14 days, the last five of which must be symptom free. If the student is still exhibiting symptoms at that time, so he or she continues to quarantine, he or she must be symptom free for 5 days before returning to school.

If the family travels outside the United States, a 14 day quarantine period is required even if symptom free.

Please inform your student's principal if you are traveling outside of the state or outside of the country. You may indicate if you want your child to distance learn for the 7 day period. If there are symptoms that cause a 14 day quarantine, or if you leave the country so need the 14 day quarantine, please indicate the need for distance learning for your child to your child's principal.

Please keep in mind that statewide testing is mandatory and all children must come to campus to participate in those. If we are diligent with our procedures, we will be able to have a safe and healthy campus for all and get the testing done so all students can be done with the 4th quarter on time, May 25th. If we are not able to test everyone during the current window, the test window will be extended into June, so at that point, our school year will be extended. Please keep your students from exposure during this 4th quarter so we are all able to finish on time.
