# JUNE SCHOLARSHIP NEWSLETTER

DEADLINES BETWEEN: July 1st & August 31st, 2023

# 1) Ennes Scholarships - \$2,500 - 5 Awards (Deadline: July 1, 2023)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Aspire to enter a career focused on the technical aspects of broadcasting.

B) Be planning to attend an accredited college or university within the United States by the Fall of 2023.

#### 2) JFLF's Welding Awards Program - \$1,000 - 95 Awards (Deadline: July 1, 2023)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be 18 years or younger and enrolled in a school or training program by the Fall of 2023.

B) Submit written reports about the welding projects you have completed. The welding project may be a structure, a repair or an item made for home, farm or shop.

#### 3) Kelly O. Memorial Nursing Scholarship - \$3,500 - 1 Award (Deadline: July 1, 2023)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a high school senior, undergraduate, or graduate student who is beginning their nursing journey or furthering their nursing career.

## 4) Pedro Zamora Young Leaders Scholarship - \$5,000 - 18 Awards (Deadline: July 15, 2023)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a current high school senior or first-year college student whose academic, extracurricular, or career pursuits are consistent with the goals of the scholarship program.

B) Demonstrate an active commitment to community justice work.

#### 5) Minecraft Scholarship - \$2,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: July 31, 2023)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a United States citizen and enrolled in college or high school.

B) Have a 3.0 or higher GPA.

#### 8) Students with Disabilities Scholarship - \$5,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: August 4, 2023)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be enrolled at an accredited college, university, or high school in the United States.
- B) Have a documented disability.

#### 9) Nursing & Pharmacy Student Scholarship - \$1,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: August 8, 2023)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a college student who is enrolled in a nursing or pharmacy program by the Fall of 2023.

B) Have a minimum Grade Point Average of 3.0.

#### 10) Fred and Diane Fitts Aviation Scholarship - \$2,500 – 4 Awards (Deadline: August 13, 2023)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be currently enrolled in high school, college, university, technical school, trade school or community college.

B) Host an American Red Cross blood drive in the United States scheduled between June 1 – August 31.

#### 13) Second Chance Scholarship - \$1,000 - 5 Awards (Deadline: August 31, 2023)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

B) Be enrolled or in the process of enrolling as a full-time student at an accredited U.S. college or university.
